ACCREDITATION

All programmes are accredited at MQF (Malta Qualifications Framework) Levels 1, 2 and 3 by the Department of Quality and Standards of Education. The majority of information sessions are carried out in person, or as live webinars for real-time interaction with industry experts. This ensures that learners receive nationally recognised qualifications that can contribute to their personal development profile. Upon successful completion of an accredited programme, participants receive a recognised certificate of achievement.

DELIVERY FORMAT

All accredited programmes are delivered in person. The majority of information sessions are carried out face-to-face, with live webinars available for real-time interaction with industry experts.

The Transport Learning Hub offers nine accredited non-formal programmes across three key sectors. Each pathway is structured across three MQF levels, providing a progressive learning journey from early childhood to upper secondary age.

NON-FORMAL AWARD IN SAFE CYCLING AND ACTIVE ROAD USE

Designed for children aged 4–7 to introduce basic road use and safe cycling behaviours in a playful, structured, age-appropriate manner. Activities are adapted to developmental stage, attention span and language proficiency to ensure accessibility, engagement and inclusion.

Planned for children aged 4–7. Introduces aviation awareness in a playful, structured, age-appropriate manner, focusing on curiosity, safety and exploration. Activities are adapted to developmental stage, attention span and language proficiency to ensure inclusion and engagement.

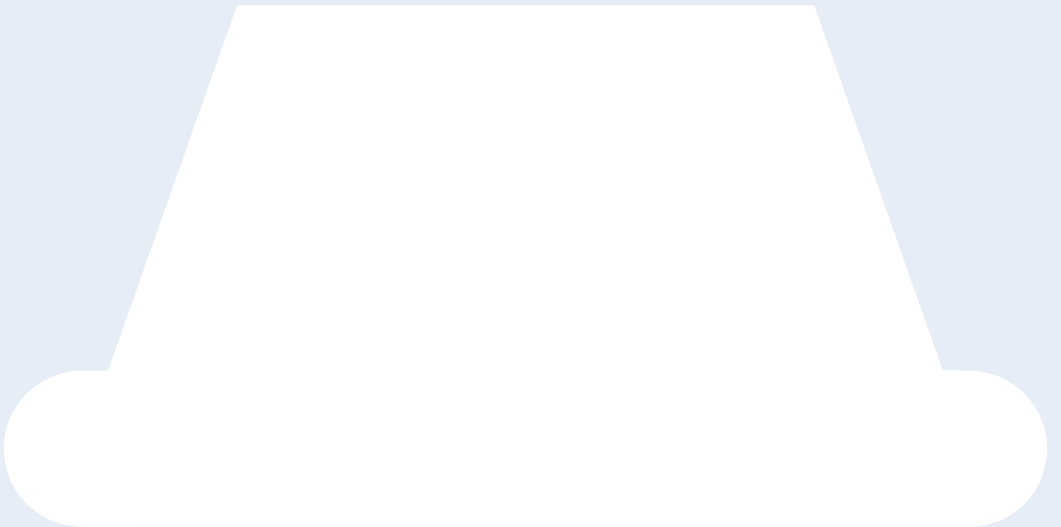
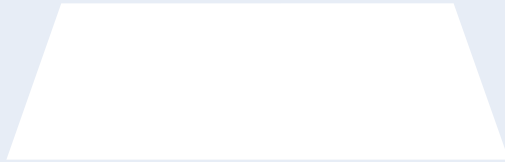
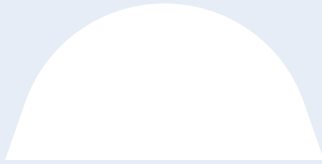
ONLINE SERIES ALTERNATIVE TECHNOLOGIES AND FUELS IN MOBILITY AND CONNECTIVITY

Intended for young people aged 9–12 (upper primary/ lower secondary). Learners face increased exposure to road risks; the programme equips them with practical skills and civic responsibility to make safe and sustainable commuting choices. Achievement may be recorded in SSQ&P.

NON-FORMAL AWARD IN PREPARING FOR RESPONSIBLE ROAD USE

Intended for young people aged 13–16 (upper secondary). As learners prepare for independent mobility and responsibilities of future driving, the programme connects scientific principles with real-life traffic safety, encourages reflection on behaviour, and builds competences for responsible participation as road users. Achievement may be recorded in the Secondary School Certificate and Profile (SSQ&P).
